What is 2-1-1?

2-1-1 is a toll-free phone number that provides information and referrals for health and social services in San Bernardino County. 2-1-1 is free and confidential, and a live, bilingual call specialist assists callers 24 hours a day. Services are available by simply dialing 2-1-1 (or 888-435-7565).
